

## Text Messaging Service Terms of Use

- 1. You may choose to receive optional SMS text messages at your mobile phone number regarding your applications for employment. Please note that this service is optional. You are not required to provide a mobile phone number or receive text messages to apply for employment through this service.
- 2. You can cancel the Text Messaging service at any time by doing one or both of the following:
  - a. From the Employment Opportunities website:
    - i. select My Applications.

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- ii. Select Update My Contact Information. Log in to your account.
- iii. From Update My Contact Information, un-check the Text/SMS box.
- iv. Click the Update My Contact Information button to save.
- b. Reply "STOP" to any message you have received from the Text Messaging service. After you send the SMS message "STOP" to us, we will send you an SMS message to confirm that you have been unsubscribed. After this, you will no longer receive SMS messages from us.
- 3. If you are experiencing issues with the messaging program you can reply with the keyword HELP for more assistance, or you can get help directly by contacting the agency where you applied for employment. Click the Contact Us link on the Employment Opportunities website to find the agency's contact information.
- 4. Carriers are not liable for delayed or undelivered messages.
- 5. As always, message and data rates may apply for any messages sent to you from us and to us from you. Message frequency may vary. If you have any questions about your text plan or data plan, it is best to contact your wireless provider.
